## *The Search for Conrad Weiser's Tan Yard*

Roger Heim introduces to us the concept of "Historical Archeology" as he explains the use of deeds, maps, newspapers, wills and other historical documents to research and confirm the location of the circa 1745 tannery at the homestead of the historic Indian interpreter and diplomat Conrad Weiser, near Womelsdorf. Come learn about this process and the individuals who owned and operated the tannery from Weiser's time until about 1890.
